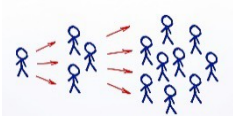
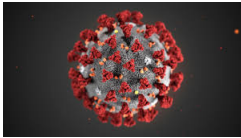


Information about coronavirus (COVID-19)

✓ We are making sure our sites are clean.



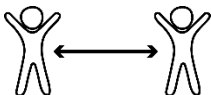
✓ We are all washing our hands.



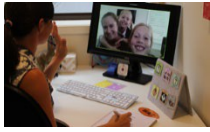
✓ We are not touching each other.

✓ We are not getting too close to each other. This is called social-distancing.



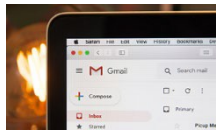
✓ We are using internet video and phone calls for:
