St John's is one of seven sites that make up Aspect Macarthur School. There are three classes at St Johns consisting of students from year K - 6. The school is part of Autism Spectrum Australia (Aspect) and as such is covered by all Aspect's policies and procedures.



Official school hours are 8:45am to 2:50pm.

Students arrive at school in the morning between 8.30am - 8.45am. At 8.45am all students line up under the COLA for the morning assembly. The students are transported to and from school via parents and special transport and are dropped off at the designated 'kiss and drop' area in the main school carpark near the office when a staff member is waiting if on transport or walked into school by parents/carer.

Students are dismissed to parents from 2.50pm. Students who travel via transport are put on their vehicle in the 'kiss and drop' area of the main car park. Transport drivers will wait in the carpark until the students and teachers arrive.

When entering the St John's Satellite class outside of drop off hours please ensure you enter via the main school office and sign in as a parent visitor. St John's office staff will call Aspect staff who will then meet you in the office or direct you up to the classroom.



Morning tea is between 11.05am - 11.45am and lunch from 1.15pm - 1:45pm. In the event of wet

weather students will play inside their classroom and/or the veranda. At all times Aspect students are supervised by Aspect staff.

John's canteen app (Flexischools) which you can download to your tablet or phone. Students wishing to buy an ice block or snack item during lunch times can use cash.



Aspect students are expected to wear the full St John's uniform at all times. Please contact the School directly regarding uniforms on 4625 1171.

Each term parents will receive a copy of the class timetable as well as a term overview. Parents will have an IP meeting with the teacher in term 1 and a review meeting in term 3. Parents will also be able to meet the teacher at a 'Meet the Teacher' evening in term 1.



This year we will be using See-Saw as the communication method for students and families at St Johns. The teacher

will correspond through here, approximately three times per week. Any important forms or notes that need to be completed and returned will be sent home in a document wallet. If there is an urgent matter please call the class teacher on 0400 779 567.
