

## Our Lady of Fatima Information Sheet for Parents

Our Lady of Fatima (OLF) is one of eleven sites that make up Aspect South East Sydney School. There are two classes at OLF; K-4Silver and 5-6 Silver. Our school is part of Autism Spectrum Australia (Aspect) and as such is covered by all Aspect's policies and procedures.

Official school hours are 8.45am to 2.45pm (Covid restricted time is 2:30pm). Students arrive at school in the morning at 8:45 am. Parents and special transport use the OLF car line to drop students where a minimum of two aspect staff members are present to supervise.



Due to Covid restrictions, students have been dismissed to parents or put on special transport from 2.30pm. As restrictions ease, this time may change and Families will be advised of this. Parents and transport drivers must not arrive into carline prior to 8:45am. If parents/drivers are early they will wait in the nearby visitor's carpark until the students and teachers arrive at carline. Parents and transport drivers must use the lane closest to the office at all time and are to remain in vehicle and Aspect staff will assist students to vehicles.

Morning tea is between 11.00 – 11.30am and lunch from 1.30 -2.10pm. The first 10 minutes of lunch all OLF students remain seated and are encouraged to eat. In the event of wet weather students will play inside their classroom. At all times Aspect students are supervised by Aspect staff.

When entering the OLF unit outside of drop off hours please ensure you enter via the main school office and sign in as a parent visitor. OLF office staff will call Aspect staff who will then meet you in the office.

Aspect students are encouraged to wear the full OLF uniform at all times.

The OLF uniform shop is open every Wednesday afternoon from  $2.45 \, \text{pm} - 3.30 \, \text{pm}$  and is located on the OLF school grounds. Second hand uniforms are available as well as new.
