We are seeking allied health practitioners and behaviour support practitioners who provide services to NDIS participants for a new study exploring the reporting of NDIS incidents under the NDIS Quality and Safeguards Commission framework.

Findings from this research will inform future practitioner training, improve reporting systems and escalation pathways, and strengthen safeguarding and incident reporting across the NDIS.
