Story retell The Very Hungry Caterpillar'

- Cut and paste activity

Use this resource to support your children to retell the story and discuss the senses they used.



Instructions

- Talk about the story and what happened e.g. first an egg lay on a leaf, then out popped a caterpillar etc.
- Talk about the senses that were used in each part of the story e.g. the apple felt crunchy, the pear tasted sweet, the plums made a squishing sound etc.
- Encourage your child to cut out each picture and paste it in the correct sequence in the table below.
- Encourage your child to retell the story in their own words using the pictures.
